Community Safety Advisory Committee:

Council's Community Safety Strategic Plan 2014-2017 provides an opportunity for community members to become involved in Council's Community Safety Advisory Committee.

The Advisory Committee brings together a cross section of people from a variety of organisations and backgrounds who share a set of beliefs, attitudes and values that support the promotion of safety and the prevention of injury and crime.

The Advisory Committee is seeking two community members with a specific interest or background which reflects one or more of the five key community safety areas identified in the Community Safety Strategic Plan:

- Preventing Violence against Women
- Alcohol and Other Drug Issues
- CBD(Central Business District) Public Safety
- Neighbourhood Safety and Wellbeing
- Perceptions of Safety

Membership is for a period of two years and the meetings are held bi-monthly commencing in February. Applications will be reviewed by a sub-committee of the Community Safety Advisory Committee and will be selected based on their involvement and/or interest in the priority areas of the Community Safety Strategic Plan.
